Camp placement and theme

The tented camp is made up of one family unit (two double accommodations and one mess) two double accommodation units on either side of the family unit all facing the views over the Mara and Serengeti and separate two double tents further away from the main camp with own mess and kitchen and driveway. Each tent is a dark green canvas to blend into the forest and superb interesting interiors. All tents are hexagon in shape with ensuite bathrooms, hot and cold-water showers, and flush toilets

All solar-powered interior lighting and solar-powered charging units are set off with candle lights, hurricane lights, and solar fairy lights. Above the undulating hillside set in a grove of forest, is the art and scent tent overlooking another magnificent view of the Serengeti.



The theme

Anthony Russell's highly personalised artifacts and art collection are placed in all units. The setting is like his private home for the enjoyment of all. The views are unlike anything else with the privileged views over the Mara and Serengeti with year-round wildlife below the tents on vast savannah grasslands. The camp is intimate and very private within its settings and moulded into the landscape.











Conservation & Community

We engage the community at the camp in all areas of hospitality training programs and conservation

We have community projects such as beekeeping, wildfowl rearing, and our heirloom-seeded vegetable gardens, located behind us

To engage more of the community in all areas of art and beading

The planting of indigenous trees

The protection of rare species such as the Giant Pangolin, in our area and beyond

To expand into the leasing land for conservation immediately around us and further out in the future on a large scale.



Location

Mara Pure Siria, sits atop the Siria escarpment that abuts the Mara and Serengeti ecosystem below the site Wild vital front and a rich rural back. The camp faces due south.

We are in a forested grass area with glades. The temperature is mild days and cold nights. The camp is within a 30-minute drive of the Mara Triangle and easy access and eleven kilometers from Kichwa Tembo Airstrip.



Vision

To enhance the connection between conservation, art, and creative senses while making these elements work for the protection of the flora and fauna at Mara Pure Siria.

To connect our friends who visit us, with art and scent making with help to create your fantasies, with fun, in an intimate setting.

To inspire, contemplate, set in the views, and be at peace between artistic moments of inspiration and relaxation.



Size

Mara Pure has only six double units, a mess area, an outdoor sky fire area, and an art tent further off the main site.
